

**Agenda for the 1st meeting of the High level Advisory Group of the UN Secretary
General on climate change financing, 31st March 2010**

Afternoon session: 1430 – 1700 - *No.10 Downing Street*

The working dinner will start at 1830 with opening remarks from Prime Minister Meles. There will follow a roundtable discussion of the key sources of climate change financing, each led by a member of the advisory group:

- the role and reform of the carbon market - options and priorities for future work
- using public instruments to leverage private finance - options and priorities for future work
